

- Create new, green-collar jobs supporting the New Energy Economy



Green Jobs and Renewable Energy

- RECOGNIZE THIS?
- LEED EXISTING BUILDING OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE
- PERFORMANCE CONTRACTING
- EXTRA SAVINGS IN THE 1ST YEAR PAID FOR SOLAR



Policies support new business development

- Renewable Portfolio Standard
 - 20% by 2020 renewable with a carve out for solar
- Solar Contractors in CO prior to Amendment 37
 - Companies 46
 - Employees- 50-75
 - Manufacturers- 0
- Today over \$48Million Invested
- 180 solar companies with 3,600 employees working not including manufacture or R&D
- Almost 40 Megawatts (MW) of installed solar: less than 1MW in 2004. 80 MW required by 2020



What is the result?

- Colorado gross product is 1.7% in the nation
- Ranks 6th in wind investment
- Ranks 6th in solar
- 1069 MW of wind power installed in Colorado;
 - ver \$1 Billion invested
- Vestas Wind has 3 facilities manufacturing facilities
- Counties with wind gain property taxes
- Siemens, AVA Solar, Conoco Phillips and a numerous other companies setting up R&D

The New Investments

- Legislation as a driver?
 - HB 07-1146-Improved local building codes
 - HB 07- 1309 GEO calls out "performance contracting," for public buildings including K-12 school buildings
 - SB 07- 51 New state buildings and buildings constructed with state funds must meet the LEED- Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design standards set by the United States Green Building Council.

The New Investments

- HB 07-1037-
- Directs the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC) to require jurisdictional electric utilities and gas local distribution companies to develop and substantially expand energy efficiency programs.

And requires investor-owned utilities to provide cost-

effective (DSM)energy efficiency programs to their customers.



State Energy Program

- State Energy Program
 - State portion \$50M
 - Primary way in which state offers efficiency and renewables services
 - Changes in Recovery Act:
 - **Waiver of 20% Matching Requirement**
 - **X** Waiver of restriction on capital investments









GEO SEP Investment Strategy

Address Barriers

ACCESS TO INFORMATION

where do I start?, who do I call?, what do I do? what incentives are available? How much does it cost? how do I pay for it?

ACCESS TO CAPITAL/FINANCING

 up front costs, subsidized commercial financing, sb 184 implementation, assistance for performance contracting, loosen credit market;

ACCESS TO SERVICES

 workforce development, training, certification, business expansion into underserved areas, advancing new energy economy curricula

GEO Weatherization

- Currently 8 State Agencies provide energy efficiency improvements to income based residences
- \$80 million funding for 2 + years
- Significant increase in # of homes
- Opportunities to provide new services in our communities
- GEO web site and regional agency contacts

Energy Efficiency Conservation Block Grant

\$42,618,700 total to Colorado

- \$ 32,878,300 directly to 20 cities and 10 counties, based on a population-related formula grant
- \$ 9,593,500 to the state energy office, of which GEO will issue no less than \$5,756,100 in subgrants to non-entitled municipalities and counties

Southern Ute Indian Tribe of the Southern Ute Reservation, Colorado \$ 71,900

CO/NM/UT Ute Mountain Tribe of the Ute Mountain Reservation, Colorado, New Mexico &Utah \$ 75,000




DOE Competitive Grant Opportunities

- GEO is interested to facilitate and create other funding sources from DOE competitive grants
- \$800 Million for Biomass
- \$400 Million for Geothermal
- \$250 Million for RE and EE Green Jobs Training
- \$300 Million for Energy Star Appliances
- \$350 Million for Retrofit Assisted Housing
- Others?
