Energy/Climate Legislation

• House

- Passed H.R. 2454 in June 2009
- Comprehensive energy and climate measure
 - Includes national RES and cap-and-trade measure
- Senate
 - S. 1462 Energy only bill passed out of ENR Committee
 - Contains RES definitions similar to House measure
 - Climate bill talks have stalled



Memorandum of Understanding

- Army Corps, Dept. of Interior, and Dept. of Energy
- Plan of Action
 - Report of growth opportunities by October
 - Commitment to upgrade federal facilities
 - Coordination of research and development
 - Increasing generation
