Inventory Items

- Frequency of use
- Procurement lead time
- Impact of unavailability
- Quantity discount

Potential inventory items

- 1. Gate end seals
- 2. Shear pins
- 3. Packings / seals (shaft, gate, blade)
- 4. Brushes / brush rigging
- 5. Bearings / bushings (guide, thrust, gate)
- 6. Pole / ammortiseur connectors
- 7. Governor (pumps, valves, motors)
- 8. Wear rings
- 9. Valve seals
- 10. Brake shoes
- 11. Wicket gates / arms / linkage
- 12. Field poles
- 13. Runner

- Scheduled
- Emergency

Scheduled maintenance

- In-house workforce planning / execution
 - scope definition
 - resource definition / allocation
 - schedule
- Contracted workforce planning / execution
 - scope definition
 - division of work / supply
 - schedule

Emergency maintenance down-time / cost minimization

- In-house workforce planning / execution
 - resource availability / definition / allocation
 - schedule impact
- Contracted workforce planning / execution
 - blanket contract in place
 - resource availability / mobilization queue
 - time and material
 - schedule impact



Outage planning

- Self executed
- Contracted

- In-house workforce planning / execution
 - Long lead definition / procurement / responsibility
 - scope definition
 - resource definition / allocation
 - schedule
- Contracted workforce planning / execution
 - project control / support division (in-house costs)
 - firm price vs. time and material
 - scope definition
 - division of work / supply
 - schedule
