Statement of the National Hydropower Association on Failure to Include Renewable Energy Incentives in the Economic Stimulus Package

Linda Church Ciocci, NHA executive director, today issued the following statement:

"The development of hydropower and new waterpower technologies could provide Americans 95,000 megawatts of clean, climate-friendly electricity as well as significant increases in jobs and investments that support local communities. The failure of the Senate this week to support the renewable energy tax provisions only serves to stifle, not stimulate, our industry and the economy."

"NHA thanks all of the supporters in the Senate who voted to include the hydropower and other renewable energy provisions in the stimulus bill. We strongly urge Congress to come together and find a way to quickly extend the incentives."
